Course title :	Humanitarian Demining Train the Trainers Course
Aim of the course :	Train individuals working within African armies or mine action organisations to give them the knowledge to teach all the basic demining skills and to become demining platoon commander within mine action programmes or peace keeping operations.

Training duration :	75 days (10 weeks / 350 hours)
Cost by student :	3 750 € (2 459 840 francs CFA)
Course capacity :	24 trainees
Reserved to Civilian people :	4 trainees

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<p>Testing and certification :</p>	<p>The trainees having passed all the theoretical and practical tests will obtain a certificate attesting their capacity to conduct basic demining courses i.e. to provide the basic skills necessary for people to locate and destroy all types of landmines.</p> <p>According to this certificate, they also obtain the qualification to work as a demining platoon commander in field operations.</p>
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
